



Item No.-1

Confirmation of the minutes of last meeting held in IQAC.

Minutes of the meeting of the IQAC members held in IQAC Cell on Wednesday, 7th of April 2021 at 1:00 PM. At the very outset, Dr. Kr. Baibhav welcomed hon'ble members to the meeting. Thereafter the agenda items were taken up for deliberations. Confirmation of minutes of the last meeting held on 28-02-2020. Minutes of the last meeting were read out by Dr. Kr. Baibhav, IQAC Coordinator and they were confirmed unanimously by all the members.

Item No.-2

To promote optimum utilisation of ICT Methods for standardisation of teaching works through Online Virtual Mode.

The agenda of promoting optimum utilisation of ICT Methods for standardisation of teaching works through Online Virtual Mode were taken up by the members of the IQAC. The coordinator emphasized about the importance of adapting these modern ways for educators with continued remote learning in place in such times emerged out of pandemic and a mode which is entirely different from conventional classroom teachings. He also insisted that teachers should prepare themselves to facilitate learning remotely through virtual medium and should turn to technology to provide engaging and meaningful learning experiences for their students online.

Dr. Santosh Kumar was of the opinion that many educators are facing multiple challenges of online mode and find themselves not at ease to teach online in unexpected shift to remote learning amidst pandemic. He also pointed problems such as abrupt disconnection including unavailability of smartphones to students especially residing in extreme rural areas, frequent power cuts and all other technical glitch among the many confrontational issues which so far as its consequence also have mounted in escalating troubles in running the online teaching programs smoothly. However, he also suggested that teachers are gradually stepping out of their comfort zones to learn new tools and online teaching strategies with optimum utilization of ICT methods.

Dr. Aditya Kumar Singh emphasized about adaptation of new teaching strategies which also includes knowing and learning how to create an environment that enriches student learning and contributes to effective instruction in dispensing education through virtual modes.

Prof. Sandeep Jaiswal opined that the institution can use to get started with setting up virtual classroom which can bring about a change in perceptions and outlooks of educators and make them more presentable in existing scenario. Doing so can help them can help them to stay productive and focused throughout and could minimize all others persistent nagging distractions that may disrupt student learning. He stressed out that the institutions should necessarily need to have invested in purchasing of new equipment such as professional cameras to record a video lessons, headsets, tripods and mini-microphones to provides higher quality synchronous virtual lessons to stream on Web Portals.

Dr. Kshitish Kumar Sir, Principal cum Chairperson stressed that there is strong need to have adapting to these new techniques as fast as we could, as this can make a huge difference, in the fast changing scenario which is much apparent in the modern leanings and teachings. Taking

these steps could make teachers feel more prepared and confident in tackling challenges of new teaching styles.

At last, all the members were agreed in this matter and they advised to the Principal and Coordinator IQAC to call a general body meeting of the teachers to make them apprised of the resolution being made about this agenda item, and further motivate them to using ICT methods in teaching.

Item No.-3

To expedite engagement of N.S.S Wing in activities to promote awareness about Corona Virus SOPs to follow.

Dr. Sandeep Kumar and Prof. Sandeep Jha, both of them underlined the necessity to promote awareness about the vaccination drives for one and all especially among the rural aging people. He also emphasized upon running motivational programs to spread awareness to this, in the enclosing areas of the campus.

Dr. Aditya Kumar Singh called for organizing workshops to allay all the sceptics relating to vaccination amongst the people as this would make them more enlightened towards the need vaccination in order to eradicate virus threats almost for ever.

Prof. Sandeep Jaiswal, who also happened to be a NSS Program Coordinator of the college informed the members about the activities so far harboured and achieved by the volunteers of N.S.S. He also gave thorough details of engaging volunteers in promoting Covid guidelines and its SOPs in the following activities such as distributions of masks to the ignorant people within the campus and outside as well. He also said that a volunteering team from amongst the NSS Unit will be made by the name of Covid Warriors to spread awareness about Covid SOPs not only through their physical participation but also through means of social media platforms in order to reach to larger masses in quick succession of time. He also stressed that NSS volunteers will also apprise people about recurrent issues of mental problems faced by many during this pandemic and would teach them about ways to overcome this.

Dr. Kshitish Kumar Sir, Principal cum Chairperson deeply appreciated not only the NSS volunteers but also the collective efforts of all the stakeholders in promoting awareness of Covid precautions through active involvements and also encouraged them to active in such activities of social cause.

Dr. Kr. Baibhav, IQAC Coordinator also acknowledged the efforts of the NSS Unit and its volunteers in taking active parts in spreading awareness about Covid precautions, its SOPs including campaign for promoting vaccination amongst the many.

Item No.-4

To discuss about the engagement of a staff to look into the matter of technical operations of computer and its work.

As IQAC Co-ordinator stressed over the need to have poignant discussion about an issue of lack of technical hand which as its consequence affecting the literary and administrative

activities regarding the institutional works who could provide valuable and reliable support in and out of the office.

Further, Prof. Sandeep Jha, who is also a coordinator of Computer Maintenance and Operational Cell at college, informed the members about an issue of lack of technical hand which as its consequence affecting the literary and administrative activities related to the institutional works who could provide valuable and reliable support in and out of the office. A similar thoughts were expressed by both Dr. Aditya Kumar Singh and Prof. Sandeep Jaiswal.

As per the agenda of the meeting, there had been a thoughtful discussion about this poignant issue and resolved unanimously by all its members to raise this point and request to the Principal Sir either to take this matter further to the higher authorities to expedite the process or to make an effort in engaging a service of technical hand to avoid unusual procrastination in order to expedite the institutional works as well as who could be of any service to technical assistance related to computer which requires complicating procedures.

Item No.-5

Up-gradation of Geography Lab with installation of Projector with Smart-Board including Computer also among the many needed items.

Prof. Sandeep Jha, opined that the laboratories have a key role in supporting the academic activities of the institution qualitatively. He opined that for proper dispensation of quality education, arrangement of apparatus and equipment is highly needed in order to cater to the need of students and give more facilities to excel and equip them with the use of tools and techniques of modern education system.

Prof. Sandeep Jaiswal informed the members that a proposal for procurement of various tools for setting up smart laboratories in the campus for which the money is already granted, is already sent to the state higher education department, to which the consent is further sought and awaited.

All the members of IQAC unanimously requested to the Principal Sir to take cognizance of this matter as urgent for having up-gradation in compliance with state of art laboratory. Later on, Prof. Sandeep Jha was authorized to prepare a detailed charts of all the logistic requirements in setting up smart laboratory equipped with projector and smart-board.

Dr. Kr. Baibhav, IQAC Coordinator also underlined the necessity to purchase of Printers for such labs in the college.

Item No.-5

Miscellaneous with the permission of the Chair.

Dr. Kumar Baibhav alongwith Sri Prashant Kumar, had been advised to make proper register for documentation of database, in order to streamline all the academic and cultural activities of the college regularly.

Dr. Sandeep Kumar and Dr. Santosh Kumar both suggested that an effort should be made to publish the college annual magazine 'BHARATI' again which could not be possible due to

outbreak of pandemic over the past few years. In order to expedite the process, it was directed by Dr. Kshitish Kumar Sir, Principal cum Chairperson that a new magazine editorial board will be constituted for publication of the college annual magazine 'BHARATI'. Dr. Santosh Kumar also suggested that there should be a proper unit to look into cultural activities of the college, for this to have, he proposed formation of 'Sahitya-Sanskriti Sambhag in the college.

Dr. Kshitish Kumar Sir, Principal cum Chairperson emphasized about the need to participate and foster the culture of organizing Webinar/Workshops on regular basis to meet to the challenges of modern educations in order to cater to the need of inquisitive learners. He also instructed IQAC Coordinator to make all the teachers apprised of these sentiments of all the members.

Members also insisted upon the matter of regular consultation of students with teachers to broaden the students' strata diversified with their regular assessment and to initiate the culture of feedback mechanism more vigorously.
